FAQs

What is the family/student portal?

Aspen is the district student management system. At a school level it contains information such as student contacts, attendance, conduct, and progress/term grades. If a teacher chooses to show grades and assignments this information is located in the 'Academics' tab.

How do I login?

The link for Aspen is available on the Weymouth school website, under the tab for Family and Students. Once you go into the login page you will see a screen for your username and password (right). Students have a unique username and password that they received in school. Family logins were emailed at the start of last school year, and are available by emailing x2chapman@weymouthschools.org



What if my email is wrong?

You need to call the school and correct it with one of our secretary staff members. The number for the school is 781-337-4500.

I heard there is a way to notify me about attendance, conduct, and grades. Where is that?

You can set Aspen to email you every Saturday morning if there are any attendance notices, conduct notices, or grades below a certain score (for teachers using the grade book feature). This is located under the Family tab - and then notifications at the bottom left.

What should I expect when teachers use the grade book?

*First, not all teachers are using the full grade book. This is currently an option for our staff. For staff members using the grade book you will see the grades once they are entered. **Please be patient.** Our staff members are learning about many new features that come out each year. Also, teachers want to ensure that grades are accurate and reflect student work. Certain assessments may take longer to grade than others.*

Are progress reports and report cards published on Aspen?

Yes. At the Middle school level they are sent both by paper and electronically. At the HS level progress reports and report cards are sent through Aspen electronically, with a paper option.
